1. DPS deems it necessary to adopt Rule 10.2.4 in order to carry out the provisions of NMSA 9-19-14 which created the law enforcement retention fund ["LERF"] with respect to the administration of the fund. The proposed rule, as amended, which is the final adopted rule, sets forth procedures : 1) for law enforcement agencies to follow in reporting (or requesting a waiver of the requirement to report) law enforcement officer retention information to DPS in order to obtain monies from the Law Enforcement Retention Fund ["LERF"] for the purpose of providing retention differential disbursements to eligible officers; 2) that DPS will follow in calculating, disbursing and, in the event of a shortfall in monies in the LERF, reducing the amount of money disbursed to law enforcement agencies to follow in returning unused monies to the DPS or in appealing DPS's calculation of the retention differential disbursement DPS intends to distribute to the requesting law enforcement agencies.

2. The effective date of the new rule is April 25, 2023.

3. The reason for changes between the published proposed rule and the final rule, which are stylistic, are to make the language more clear and to update the format of the state e-mail address.

4. There were no substantive changes to the rule proposed through public argument. The procedural arguments to the rulemaking process were deemed irrelevant or not substantive.
